William had a particular interest in history and was an accomplished writer. His wishes were that the scholarships be awarded to seniors pursuing a degree in journalism (communications).

Below are the scholarship guidelines and information along with an attached scholarship application. The Alumni Scholarships will be awarded at the annual Senior Recognition Assembly.

**SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

- 1) Applicant must be a Senior at Hoover High School and will be graduating with his/her class.
- 2) Applicant must have been accepted into a college, university or other post-secondary school, and must be pursuing a degree in journalism (communications).
- 3) Applicant must have at least a 2.00 cumulative grade point average.
- 4) Applicant must secure three (3) letters of recommendation. At least two of these must be members of the Hoover High School faculty or administration.
- 5) Applicant must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining career objectives and why he/she wishes to be considered for this scholarship.
- 6) All information on the application will be verified either through the Hoover High School Guidance Office or the college/university listed.
- 7) The completed application, letters of recommendation and essay are due in the Hoover High Guidance Office no later than March 15.
- 8) Scholarship money will be mailed out in September.
