New North Canton School Buildings Update

ork continues on the community's two newest school buildings. The Primary School is being built on the corner of Charlotte Street and Hillcrest NW, the original location of No-Ca-Hi/North Canton Jr. High/North Canton Middle School. It will house Pre-school through 2nd Grade students. The new Intermediate Building, which will house 3rd through 5th Grade students, is being constructed on East Maple Street on property adjacent to the

current Clearmount Elementary School.

Underground utilities and building slabs are scheduled to be completed by the end of July. Interior non-bearing masonry walls are to be completed by the end of September. Structural steel construction should be finished by the end of October, and exterior walls, windows and roofing completed by sometime

in December this year.

2023 will see a flurry of activity with all of the drywall, interior trim, painting, interior finishes and site development completed.

Bina Mehta, MD, Class of 1987 – a leader in pain management in northeast Ohio.


Kyle Putinski, Class of 2003 – a leader in the area non-profit sector, currently executive director of the local Big Brothers/Big Sisters organization.
